The Dayton LGBT Film fest is celebrating its tenth year of insightful, challenging and thought-provoking pieces with films that focus on subjects of interest to the LGBT community. Festival passes are \$50.00, which go on sale on September 12 and often sell out quickly, with single tickets going on sale September 19.

This year the festival kicks off on Oct 8th with **“Fourth Man Out”** which examines a small-town, blue-collar guy who lets his friends know he’s gay - and what happens when they



try to help him find a boyfriend. This film is followed by **“Guidance”** on Oct 9th. David Gold, 36, a pathologically immature former child actor, has never been able to get over high school. Recently diagnosed with skin cancer, unemployed and with nothing left to lose, he fakes his resume and gets a job as a high school guidance counselor.



Quickly winning over the students at Grusin High with his laid-back attitude and similar interests, he befriends Jabrielle, a teenaged outcast and soon learns that sometimes you can go too far.

Saturday’s offerings of “Top Drawer Shorts” are a DO NOT MISS collection of wonderful, thoughtful and oft funny films that will be sure to melt your heart. At 3 pm join famed cabaret star Hedda Lettuce for a special interactive screening of the cult classic, **“Mommie Dearest.”**

At 7:30 pm it is **“Margarita With A Straw”** Undeterred



by cerebral palsy, Laila embarks on a journey of sexual discovery. Her exhilarating adventures cause a rift both within herself and with those she is closest to. Ultimately, it is in the intensity of these bonds that she finds the

strength to be truly herself.

Then at 9:45 the festival will present, **“Seed Money”** an inside look at Falcon Studios gay porn mogul, Chuck Holmes. Chuck’s business brings him fortune beyond imagining, and powerful friends, but when he attempts to channel his millions into a gay rights movement of the 90s, he finds that his money is sometimes more welcome than he is.



Sunday offers three films, **“Out To Win,” “Eisenstein In Guanajuato”** and **“Nasty Baby”** which are certainly in the realm of thought provoking pieces. **“Nasty Baby”**



is a provocative dark comedy from Sundance which has inspired both walk-outs and high praise.

All together the 2015 Dayton LGBT film festival offers many interesting films that you simply cannot miss. I suggest getting a pass for the entire festival but if that is unavailable, simple make sure you purchase as many single showing tickets you can. You will not be disappointed.


