Greater Dayton Pride Planning Is Kicking Into High Gear!

Planning for the 2016 Dayton PRIDE Celebration, “Celebrating 40 years,” has begun with some very exciting new additions to PRIDE and the PRIDE Weekend Line-up.

PRIDE month begins with a PRIDE interfaith service on Thursday June 2nd at 6 pm held at St John’s UCC /Eternal Joy MCC.



PRIDE weekend kicks off with an “Affair on the Square” at 5 pm, on Friday June 3rd a beer and food truck rally featuring

The Rubi Girls and more. This year you will also be able to reserve VIP seating for the fabulous show! Following the “Affair on the Square” be sure to join us for the .5K Bar Crawl as we visit each of our downtown LGBT friendly bar establishments.

Saturday June 4th we kick off PRIDE DAY with a 5K run sponsored by PFLAG with a starting lineup and Riverview Trail. We will provide more details on this as they become available.

June 4th at 9 am is our Annual PRIDE Breakfast at MJ’s on Jefferson. Stop in and fuel up for a long celebratory day of PRIDE.

Lineup for the PRIDE Parade begins at 11 am at the corner of Second Street and St Clair Streets with step-off at noon. Our parade route will once again from St Clair street turn right onto Third street to Jefferson Street, where the parade will turn right down to Second Street. At Second Street the parade will turn Left marching down to Main Street.

Turning Left onto main and marching down to enter into Courthouse Square where the parade will be greeted by the awaiting crowd at the PRIDE festival. New at the PRIDE Festival this year is an youth and kids area featuring games and festivities for all ages. This area will also feature a small stage with special entertainment , with festivities running from noon until 5 pm. The PRIDE festivities are not over; join us at the Victoria Theatre at 8 pm for the Dayton Gay Men’s Chorus in concert along with special guests from the Louisville, Kentucky Gay Men’s Chorus. The Louisville Chorus is only in their second season and together both choruses will further their theme of Unity. This will be a night to remember!

On Sunday January 5th at 1 pm at Welcome Park (behind Welcome Stadium off of Edwin C. Moses Blvd) we add a new event this year: Spikes & Heels. A round robin kickball tournament, think Columbus’ “Bat & Rouge” as girls in high heels take on those in spikes as the hilarity ensues. Come join in the fun!


