Coming Out Ball



The Greater Dayton LGBT Center, in recognition of "National Coming Out Day," is hosting our first ever COMING OUT BALL! The Ball will be held on October 22nd @ 7 P.M. at THE DAYTON RACQUET CLUB in the Kettering Tower, 40 N. Main Street in downtown Dayton. Ticket are \$15 for center members and \$20 for non-members.

Every year on National Coming Out Day, we celebrate coming out as lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, queer (LGBTQ) or as an ally. On Oct. 11, 2016, we will mark the 28th anniversary

of National Coming Out Day.

28 years ago, on the anniversary of the National March on Washington for Lesbian and Gay Rights, we first observed National Coming Out Day as a reminder that one of our most basic tools is the power of coming out. One out of every two Americans has someone close to them who is gay or lesbian. For transgender people, that number is only one in 10.

Coming out - whether it is as lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, queer or allied - STILL MATTERS. When people know someone who is LGBTQ, they are far more likely to support equality under the law. Beyond that, our stories can be powerful to each other. Our stories can sometime aid others to come out. Sometimes our stories can help heal someone coming to terms with issues in their own lives. As a part of our Coming Out Ball we ask you to share your coming out story. The Greater Dayton LGBT Center has set up a link on Eventbrite where you can go and sign up to share your story. Ask the Doc

Dear Dr. Bob..... I have a problem every time I shave my pubic area, I come up with itchy red bumps. What can I do about that? signed Smoothie.

Answer: Well, shaving is a popular thing still, styles differ with what you are trying to achieve.!!!

Unfortunately, if you do not shave on a regular basis... more than 2-3 times per week....just about everyone comes up with those itchy red bumps that are a consequence of both mechanical irritation and skin bacteria that now have a new place to grow.... the shaven hair follicles. The easiest thing to do is to get an over the counter antibiotic cream like bacitracin... and mix that with a mild hydrocortisone cream also over the counter... Then apply to the area once or twice daily immediately after shaving . You'll find that you can prevent the bumps entirely. Then make sure you use a clean razor every time you shave.

I should make clear that these itchy red spots.. should be flat and not raised bumps, this would suggest a different problem such as molluscom contagiosum or human papilloma warts.. Both of these are viral warts that will be spread by shaving and should be treated medically by your doctor. So, make sure you know the difference.

The Greater Dayton LGBT center launched a survey in 2004 & a follow up survey in 2014 of our LGBT community to discover the needs and wants within our community. One of our questions dealt with a physical space for our center.. Ninety eight percent of the responders stated their desire to have a permanent physical space as a home for the LGBT center. Since that time we have been searching for a home.

The Center reached out to the Downtown Dayton Partnership seeking a space. They recommended 12 locations as a possible home for our center. One of those recommended locations is developing into a viable location.

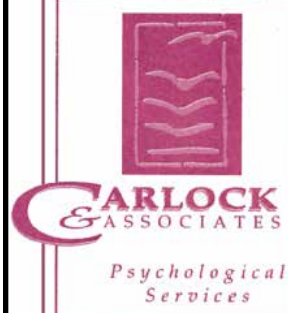
