Programs of the LGBTQIA Center

The Greater Dayton LGBT Center is continuing to expand the programming for our LGBTQIA community. With current programs such as pride, our quarterly dinner series, Newsletters and website and of course our annual resource guide we now offer an LGBT AA group on Mondays. The purpose of LGBT Alcoholics Anonymous

is a fellowship of men and women who share their experience, strength and hope with each other that they may solve their common problem and help other to recover from



alcoholism/addiction. The primary purpose is to stay clean and sober and help others achieve sobriety.



The center has begun to offer a *FREE* Yoga group on Wednesday, July 12th, from 7:00PM

- 8:15PM. This is a beginner's level class, offered for all ages and body types. The class is led by Matt Turner, Registered Yoga Teacher (RYT-200) credentialed through Yoga Alliance. Matt is a founding member of the Dayton Yoga Club, as well as former teacher at Practice Yoga. Bring your yoga mat, towel, and water bottle and join us in a non-judgmental atmosphere!

In conjunction with our partners the Center also offers free HIV-STI testing events for both male and female folk a few times per year.

Additionally we have a Young Artist Showcase for our youth ages 13-20.



We also offer safe space training, transgender awareness, sensitivity and diversity training to schools, businesses and other organizations.

peruse our collections of LGBT books that will be available for both research and check-out for a read in the privacy of your own home. You can even sign up for



one of our LGBT history classes in which we teach LGBT history of local and national history events and persons. We will also offer public computers that you may come to the safe-space of the center to do research on a variety of topics.

We hold Pride each summer to commemorate the Stone-wall Riots June of 1969. At the time, most states had laws banning LGBT people from assembling in groups. Despite being illegal, the mob opened LGBT bars to profit off of the open discrimination of our community. The bars were the only safe space for LGBT people and were frequently raided by police officers looking for bribes. Tired of harassment and discrimination, the patrons of The Stonewall protested and began a series of actions that turned into several days of riots. At its peak, more than 1,000 people took to the streets of Greenwich Village in one of the first organized displays of LGBT protest. The mostly transgender patrons of color at The Stonewall are credited with starting the LGBT civil rights movement.

It is so wonderful when we all come together as community and stand up to show our PRIDE realizing where we came from and the work yet ahead. Happy Pride Dayton!



The Center Names Library - by Jim McKinnon

The Greater Dayton LGBT Center is pleased to announce the naming of our Library at the Center. It will be called the Leon Bey Memorial Library. Leon Bey was a long time resident of Dayton where he worked for the Dayton Metro Library for over 30 years and was responsible for many programs at the library. He was a lover of history and shared his love of history with all who would listen. Leon was famous for leading history walks through Dayton, often wearing a black cape, speaking fluently of ghosts, long-for-gotten business moguls, the Miami-Erie Canal, famous Daytonians, and more famous visitors to Dayton and murders!

Leon Bey served as President of the Board of the Greater Dayton LGBT Center until 2000 when he suggested his own replacement. Leon remained active with the LGBT community. In 2009 he played a crucial role in having the first Ohio Historical Marker which indicates a persons sexual orientation dedicated to Natalie Clifford Barney. The marker was ensconced in Cooper Park in Dayton adjacent to the Dayton Metro Library, and can still be seen today.

Leon was always searching for the latest in LGBT cinema, art, and theater events that educated and inspired LGBT Center members and the community as a whole.
