Upcoming Events with the LGBTQ Center

Join us Saturday September 21, for our next edition of our dinner series. For this dinner we have selected to do another Mystery Dinner. When we did this in 2017 it was a great hit, so we want to try it again. As you arrive, if you wish, you may choose to read as a character in our drama as the story unfolds. Then you must use your sleuthing skills to determine who did this dastardly deed. Doors will open at 5 pm for social hour with dinner served at 6 pm. After dinner the mystery begins. As always the dinner is free to our LGBTQ community. If you wish, please bring a side dish to share. The main dish: lasagna, garden salad and garlic bread will be provided. So join us for a great meal and fun evening. If last time was any indicator, you will be talking about it for weeks.

On September 25 at 7 pm we offer a seminar on Retirement Planning: Never to Early~Never to Late. Attendees will be enter in a chance to win one of three Kroger gift cards.

On October 9th at 6 pm the Center will once again offer an evening for National Coming Out Day which is typically celebrated on October 11th. Join us for coming out stories from all eras.

Additionally the Center has been selected again this year to host the Gala for the Dayton LGBT Film Festival on October 11th after the screening of CIRCUS OF BOOKS by director Rachel Mason. CIRCUS OF BOOKS is a film about straight couple and their family who became owners of an LGBT bookstore and porn shop in West Hollywood. What was expected to be a brief sideline led to their becoming fully immersed in the LGBT community as they took over a local store

The LGBT film festival for 2019 has an exciting line up that you will not want to miss. First up on Thursday

October 10th AT 7:30 PM we begin with GAY CHORUS DEEP SOUTH a film about the San Francisco Gay Men's Chorus as they tour the American Deep South in hopes of uniting us in a time of difference.

We spoke of Friday's screening of CIRCUS OF BOOKS and the Gala. Then on Saturday is the infamous TOP DRAWER SHORTS at 12:30 pm and the feature film SAINT FRANCES. A film about an unplanned pregnancy just as Bridget lands a new job Nanning the six-year-old daughter of an affluent lesbian couple only to come to terms with the with the true adult in this whole mad cap of scenario, the six year old.

At 7:30pm we screen QUEERING THE SCRIPT a filmed discussion of the lack of Queer female representation on television featuring interviews with some of today's top TV show cast members. Then at 9:30 pm SCREAM QUEEN! MY NIGHTMARE ON ELM STREET. The Advocate dubbed 1985's A Nightmare on Elm Street 2: Freddy's Revenge the gayest horror film ever made. For the film's closeted young star, Mark Patton, such a tag was a stark reminder about the homophobia rampant in Hollywood at the time.

Sunday October 13th we begin at 12:30 with UNSETTLED A documentary revealing the untold stories of LGBT refugees and asylum seekers who have fled intense persecution from their home countries. At 3 pm, THE BLOND ONE a story of machismo and ultimate attraction of roommates. And finally the movie not to miss at 6 pm is STRAIGHT UP a story of intellectual soul-mates, one gay one straight and a twisted love story without the thrill of copulation that will leave you with a warm heart and a smile. FREE HIV/STI Testing

Join us on October 26, 2019 for FREE HIV/STI Screening at the LGBTQ Center. For testing we have partners with Equitas Health and the Dayton Montgomery County Health Department to provide these FREE screenings. On the 26th we will offer screenings for HIV, Syphilis, Gonorrhea, and Chlamydia. The HIV testing will offer results that evening. The other tests will be sent to a lab, with results within 3 days. If you do not hear from the lab, assume all results are negative.
